- Course Requirements: You will need to bring the following items to class every day:
-Textbook (bring when asked) -Pen or pencil
-Paper -Spiral Notebook
-Highlighter
- Vocabulary: *Vocabulary is an important part of anatomy and physiology. There will be quizzes on the vocabulary words every chapter.
- Classwork: *Anatomy and Physiology is a hands-on activity based class with many classroom activities and laboratory assignments
*All classroom assignments must be done and turned in through the spiral due on test days.
- Dissections: *Anatomy and Physiology requires you to participate in dissections. Alternate assignments are available. You will be working in groups for the dissections so choose your dissection group wisely. One or two people will have to be actively involved in the dissection. All group members will be required to participate in some way, we will discuss this when we get closer to dissections.
- Assessment: *There will be vocabulary quizzes, quizzes, tests, labs, presentations, dissections and group projects.
- Lab Practicals: *Lab Practicals must be taken on the day that they are given. There will be no make ups for lab practicals due to the immense amount of time that is needed to set up and take down.
- Spiral: * More information about the spiral next week. All work must be put in the spiral notebook and turned in on test days

- Make up Procedures: *All laboratory assignments must be made up with alternative assignments of equal value
*Assessment assignments can be made up with excused absences - there will be a makeup deadline each month for any assessments taken that month.
*It is the responsibility of the student to determine the assignments missed during an absence by asking group members, checking the board, or asking me
*Any student absent on the day an assignment is due is responsible for turning it in on the day he or she returns to class
- Late Work: If the assignment is not turned in at the time collected it will be considered late. Late work is accepted for ½ credit within one week of the due date
- Office Hours: *Time for you to come in and get help, study, retake quizzes, take missing quizzes or tests (taking quizzes and tests is only on Friday during office hours)
- Retakes: *You can retake quizzes (not vocab quizzes) during office hours. You must come in one day during office hours to complete an assignment/activity to practice the content before you can take the retake quiz on another office hour day.
- Cell Phones: *Students will be required to put cell phones into a clear plastic container during all tests and quizzes (including during office hours) and during some lessons. If cell phones become an issue then they will be placed in the container the entire period every period. The container will be only used for their table, so cell phones will not be switched around.
